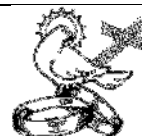

## SUMMER REFRESHMENTS

This fellowship will begin on June 27<sup>th</sup> and our hosts will be our Nursing Ministry. The ***Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*** adopted by the U.S. bishops requires that dioceses "will have mechanisms in place to respond promptly to any allegation where there is reason to believe that sexual abuse of a minor has occurred." The *Charter* also notes that "the procedures for those making a complaint will be readily available in printed form and will be the subject of periodic public announcements." The Diocese of Camden has established a toll-free number (1-800-964-6588) for those who wish to report allegations of past or current sexual abuse by any diocesan or parish employee. This is being overseen by Barbara Gondek, a licensed clinical social worker. Ms. Gondek is responsible for making appropriate referrals of abuse reports to county prosecutors and/or the N.J. Division of Youth and Family Services (DYFS). She also stands ready to assist victims/survivors who wish to inquire about counseling or other support services. The diocese urges anyone who is in need of assistance with counseling and/or support services, or who is aware of past or present cases of sexual abuse of minors, to contact Ms. Gondek at this number.
